County of Cork Road Traffic Special Speed Limit (National Roads) Bye-Laws 2023

Explanatory Notes

The County of Cork Road Traffic Speed Limits (National Roads) Bye-Laws 2023 replace the County of Cork Road Traffic Special Speed Limits (National Roads) Bye-Laws 2020, which are revoked on the coming into operation of the 2023 Bye-Laws.

The following are the further explanations for the interpretations set out in these Bye-Laws:

1. “**built up area**” has the meaning assigned to it by the Road Traffic Act 2004, and means the area of a city, a borough or a town, within the meaning of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014.

For the purposes of these Bye-Laws, “built up area” means the area within the limits of the former Town Council boundaries.

2. ‘**Built - up area speed limit**’ has the meaning assigned to it by Section 5 of the Road Traffic Act 2004 and sets out a default speed limit of 50km per hour for all public roads (other than a motorway) in built - up areas. The abolition of Town Councils in 2014 has not affected this meaning, definition and scope of these built-up areas, thus the default speed limit for all roads within these areas remains at 50km per hour, unless amended by a special speed limit bye-law. These ‘built-up areas’ are listed under No. 7 below.

The built-up area speed limit does not apply to a road or part of a road in a built-up area where a special speed limit or a road works speed limit applies to that road or part of that road.

3. **Default speed limits** apply, except where special speed limits (Section 9) or road works speed limits (Section 10) apply, and subject to the provisions of Section 11 (offence of exceeding speed limit) of the Road Traffic Act 2004, to the following public road categories:

- ‘Built-up area default speed limit’ is 50km per hour for all mechanically propelled vehicles.
- National Roads default speed limit is 100km per hour, and motorway default speed limit is 120km per hour, other than such roads in ‘built-up areas’, for all mechanically propelled vehicles.

4. **Periodic special speed limits** apply a special reduced speed limit for a specified period or periods during any day on all or on specified days, on a specified public road or part of a public road. For the purposes of these Bye-Laws, periodic special speed limits apply to public roads, as set out in the Ninth Schedule attached to these Bye-Laws.

During all other times, the default or special speed limit for that road / location applies.

5. **Road Works Speed Limits** - As provided for in Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act of 2004, where a Road Works Speed Limit Order is in place, this takes precedence over any default or special speed limit on that section of road, included in these Bye-Laws.

6. Speed Limit applies to a road in both directions unless otherwise specified.

1. Introduction

Cork County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), as amended by Section 86 of the Road Traffic Act 2010 (No.25 of 2010), and Section 22 of the Road Traffic Act 2016 (No. 21 of 2016) and following consultation with An Garda Síochána, and with the consent of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, hereby makes the following bye-laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative area of the County of Cork.

2. Title and Citation

These bye-laws may be cited as the **County of Cork Road Traffic Special Speed Limits (National Roads) Bye-Laws 2023**

3. Commencement Date

These bye-laws shall come into operation on the . 1st July 2023

4. Revocations

The following Special Speed limit Bye-laws are hereby revoked, on the coming into operation of these 2023 Bye-Laws:

County of Cork Road Traffic Special Speed Limits (National Roads) Bye-Laws, 2020, with the exception of those bye-laws adopted in 2011, listed in Appendix A, of this document which are to be retained.

5. Interpretations

In These bye-laws:

"The Act of 1961" means the Road Traffic Act 1961 (No. 24 of 1961).

"The Act of 1993" means the Roads Act 1993 (No. 14 of 1993).

"The Act of 2001" means the Local Government Act 2001.

"The Act of 2004" means the Road Traffic Act 2004 (No. 44 of 2004).

"The Act of 2010" means the Road Traffic Act 2010 (No. 25 of 2010).

"The Act of 2014" means the Road Traffic Act 2014 (No. 3 of 2014).

"The Act of 2016" means the Road Traffic Act 2016 (No. 21 of 2016).

"The Local Government Act of 2014" means the Local Government Reform Act 2014 (No.1 of 2014).

"administrative area" has the meaning assigned to it by the Local Government Act of 2001 (as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014)

"Administrative area of the County of Cork" means the administrative area of Cork County Council.

c) Where these Byelaws refer to a particular distance from a junction, that distance shall be measured from the intersection between the centre points of the Roads which intersect at the junction in question to the location of the speed limit sign(s).

8. First Schedule - 20km/h

Twenty kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles, on any of the roads specified in the First Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

9. Second Schedule - 30km/h

Thirty kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on any of the roads specified in the Second Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

10. Third Schedule - 40km/h

Forty Kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles, on any of the roads specified in the Third Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

11. Fourth Schedule - 50km/h

Fifty Kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles, on each of the roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

12. Fifth Schedule - 60km/h

Sixty Kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on each of the roads specified in the Fifth Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

13. Sixth Schedule - 80km/h

Eighty kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on each of the roads specified in the Sixth Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

14. Seventh Schedule - 100km/h

One hundred kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on each of the roads specified in the Seventh Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

15. Eighth Schedule - 120km/h

One hundred and twenty kilometres per hour shall be the special speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles, on any of the roads specified in the Eighth Schedule to these Bye-Laws.

16. Ninth Schedule - Periodic Special Speed Limits

The Ninth Schedule sets out the special reduced speed limit to be applied for mechanically propelled vehicles on specified roads or parts thereof for a specified period, or periods, during any day, on all or on specified days.
